

OUR STORY

The Environmental Education Foundation was founded in 1980 as an affiliate of the Geneva Lake Association (GLA). During its 38 year history, the Foundation has awarded more than \$650,000 in college scholarships, and outdoor education awards to over 500 lake area youth, from 5th grade through graduate school. Over the years, the Foundation assets and income have grown from the consistent support of area residents, allowing the EEF to fund over \$43,000 in awards and grants to deserving students in the Geneva Lake area during the 2018-2019 school year.

The EEF has a unique and distinct focus that promotes environmental awareness around the lake and financially supports environmental education experiences for Geneva Lake area youth.

The Foundation is an independent, not-for-profit, tax exempt 501 (c) (3) organization, governed by a Board of Directors and By-laws.
